CYTOGENETICS

1. Chromosome Analysis:

for diagnosis of common chromosomal disorders such as

Down syndrome.

Turner syndrome.

Klinefelters syndrome.

Edward's syndrome

Recurrent miscarriages and other congenital disorders.

2. Cancer Cytogenetic Analysis:

Detection of Philadelphia chromosome or other characteristic cytogenetic markers associated with leukemia.


3. Sex Anomaly & Infertility:


