The meeting was chaired by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Saikat Maitra.

The meeting was called on an emergency basis particularly to discuss on the holding of the Intermediate Examinations for students based on the Advisory from State Government and to finalize the date of the commencement of the next academic year 2020-2021.

# I. Agenda No.1: Confirmation of the minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 through Zoom App.

The minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 through Zoom App was placed in the meeting for confirmation by Registrar (Minutes was already circulated to the members).

Resolved: The minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on 21st August through Zoom App was accepted for confirmation with the following amendment:

"With respect to Agenda No.6: Report on the introduction of new courses in the academic session 2020-21, the renaming of the School of Natural & Applied Sciences shall be as School of Natural, Applied and Social Sciences instead of School of Natural, Applied and Behavioural Sciences".

II. Agenda No.2: Placed for consideration the report on holding of the Intermediate Examinations for students.

The report on holding of the Intermediate Examinations for students was placed in the meeting by Controller of Examinations (Annexure-I). The salient features of the report being:

## 1. Regular students of intermediate semesters:

a. The assessment process of the intermediate students would be initiated from 29<sup>th</sup> Sept 2020 and carried out as per following schedule.

29/09/2020: Availability of forms and submission of application form by the regular and Back Paper candidates

03/10/2020: Last date for the students for online submission of the forms.

06/10/2020: Last date for confirmation/ verification by the colleges for eligibility of the students.

08/10/2020: Last date for submission of the Fee online by the students or colleges.

10/10/2020: Tentative date for generation of admit Cards.

12-17/10/2020: Dates for submission of assignment (out of 20 marks), Practical final (out of 60), sessional /grand viva/ project (out of 100) marks in university portal.

b. 20% marks would be awarded based on 'assignment based evaluation'. Colleges would to submit marks for the intermediate semester students based on assessment of assignments of the intermediate semester already done/ through different suitable modes following Covid-19 norms. The marks would be submitted in the university portal after form fill-up process. Colleges would keep records of the assignments which need to be made available to the University after Covid-19 situation gets normalized, if required.

80% marks would be awarded based on continuous assessment and attendance. 75% marks would be taken from best three of four continuous assessments already submitted in the examination portal. 5% marks would be awarded based on attendance. Imposition of lockdown would be treated as 'classes attended'.

c. If a student wishes to appear in a formal examination instead of 'alternate evaluation method', he/she would be given an opportunity to apply for the same which would be held only after Covid-19 situation gets normalized.

The final result would be revised as per student's performance in the special examinations, irrespective of whether a student secures more or less marks than what is awarded to him/her through the 'alternate evaluation method'.

- 2. Students of intermediate semesters with back papers in earlier semester and special supplementary:
  - a. All such students of intermediate semesters, who have back paper in earlier semester(s) in one or more subjects, would appear in conventional examination process for 70 marks in offline mode as and when situation would be permissible.
  - b. Special supplementary examinations for final year would also be conducted along with the other back paper candidates of intermediate semesters in a similar process.
  - c. However form fill up for all such candidates would be completed with the form fill up process of regular candidates.

Resolved: The report was accepted unanimously on holding of the Intermediate examinations for the students and following steps as proposed were accepted for implementation:

- a. The process would be intimated to the HED, Govt. of WB for appraisal on 28.09.2020 itself.
- b. The execution process would be notified for all concerned as approved on 29.09.2020.
- c. Colleges would be directed to complete the process of assignment based evaluation to evaluate out of 20 marks for the students of intermediate semester through different suitable modes following Covid-19 norms. They may consider the assignments already given to the students in the current semester or can exercise now, if not done so far through different suitable modes following Covid-19 norms.
- d. Application/form fill up process for 'alternate evaluation method' would be initiated through online examination portal for all intermediate, back paper & special supplementary students immediately and would be completed by 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020.
  - e. Admit card for eligibility for alternate evaluation method would be issued within  $10^{\text{th}}$  October 2020.
  - f. Marks for assignments, practical and sessional subjects would be collected during 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October 2020 through online examination portal.
  - g. Processing of marks and publication of result preferably would be within 31st October 2020
  - a. Admit card for back paper and special supplementary candidates would be issued only after finalization of schedule of offline examinations depending on the Covid-19 pandemic situation and government advisories regarding reopening of institutions.
    - III. Agenda No.3: Placed for consideration the report to finalize the date of commencement of the next Academic Session.

The report on the commencement of the next academic year 2020-2021 was placed in the meeting by the Gontroller of Examinations which is as follows:

- a. Academic Year 2021 would commence from November 2020 in online/offline / blended mode. However physical attendance of the students in the institutions is advised only after appropriate order of the Government based on Covid-19 pandemic situation.
- b. Odd Semester for all programs would commence from 02.11.2020 and continue till 20.02.2021 (sixteen weeks).

- c. Examinations to be completed within 27.03.202.
- d. Evan Semester to commence from 29.03.2021 and continue till 17.07.2021 (sixteen weeks).
- e. Evan Semester Examinations to be completed within 14.08.2021.
- f. All above dates are tentative and would depend upon Covid-19 pandemic situation and advisories of Govt and statutory bodies.
- g. Credit transfer from MOOCs platforms would be available.
- h. Pattern of continuous assessment and end semester examinations would be decided based on the intensity of Covid-19 pandemic situation and government advisories in this matter.

**Resolved:** The report on the commencement of next academic year 2020-2021 as placed in the meeting by the Controller of Examinations was unanimously accepted for necessary implementation.

IV. Agenda No.4: To place for consideration the progress in credit Transfer Schemes in different MOOC's Platform.

Controller of Examinations reported in the meeting regarding strategic alliance with Coursera for credit transfer schemes in different MOOC's Platform. He stated based on the decisions of earlier meetings, a list of mapped courses from NPTEL/SWAYAM platform for AICTE programs has already been published for credit transfer scheme.

Strategic alliance with Coursera has been made so that students of University and affiliated colleges can get the Coursera licenses at a very low rate and take MOOCs courses on Coursera for the purpose of credit transfer, academic improvement, skill development, taking course for MAR, MOOCs for Honours purpose and online project.

Some of the affiliated colleges have already signed order form and some are in progress.

To implement credit transfer, the colleges may submit the list of courses for credit transfer scheme to the office of CoE and through appropriate process, the same would be allowed from the academic year 2020-21.

#### Resolved:

- (i) The report was accepted for implementation.
- (ii) Further resolved that for university to take a decision on the courses for which licenses to be acquired for Coursera, Controller of Examinations to hold a meeting with the Directors of different Schools and Heads of the different Departments for finalizing.

V. Agenda No.5: Placed for consideration a reporting on the Entrance Examinations being conducted in the University for Admission to various courses for the academic year 2020-2021.

A report was placed in the meeting on the holding of the CET, JEMAT & PGET by Controller of Examinations. It was stated that two Common Entrance Test (CET)s for Non AICTE UG & PG courses, two JEMATs for Management courses and one PGET for admission in M Tech courses were conducted as per following details.

- (iii) For admission through PGET like previous years a notification may be issued by Registrar inviting applications for direct admission maintaining norms immediately after the admission process through PGET examinations ends on 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.
- (iv) The notification for holding of CET-III & JEMAT-III to be published end of September and as proposed applications may be seeked from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 till 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 and examinations can be held on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 and results by 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 keeping in the backdrop that the admission process be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 as the new session is commencing from 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2020.
- VI. Agenda No.6: Placed for consideration the report on BOS approved minutes in B. Tech IT, B. Sc & M.Sc IT with specialization, BCA & MCA and M. Tech in IT, AI, Data Science, IOT and Geo-informatics.

The report of the BOS Minutes of the Meeting (annexure-II) was placed in the meeting by Head, Information Technology on the following programs:

- (iv) A draft of the advertisement to be published is to be sent to the Registrar for publication.
