

Uniform Structure for M.Sc. Curriculum

As suggested in the BOS meeting held on 30.06.2015 and approved by the Honourable Vice Chancellor

Syllabus Content:

- Syllabus is divided into Core & Elective Papers.
- Syllabus has Theory, Practicals, Seminars, Project Work & Grand Viva.
- Industrial training is also included.

Syllabus Structure:

- There are 7 papers per semester divided into theory and practicals.
- There are 4 - 5 theory papers in the first and second semesters with 3-2 practicals.
- There is a 4-6 weeks of industrial or research laboratory training after second semester.
- There is a seminar leading to project work with literature survey of credit 2 in the third semester.
- There are 6 credits for project work in the fourth semester divided into 2 for internal assessment and 4 for project defense through seminar.
- There will be 4 credits of grand viva at the end of fourth semester.
- Total Credits should lie between 92 to 96.

Credit system:

- ➔ 1 hour theory/wk = 1 credit point.
- ➔ 3 hrs of practical/wk = 2 credits or 2 practical hours/wk = 1 credit
- ➔ Sometimes each theory paper has 100 marks and Practical is divided into 80+20=100;
- ➔ Sometimes each paper carries 50 marks.

Duration:

- ✓ 90 days / semester
- ✓ Attendance minimum of 75%
- ✓ A student registering for end-semester examination will be promoted to the next semester.
